

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 27 02 2019

That Port St Mary Commissioners disclose all information held in, but not limited to papers, correspondence, meeting records, business plans, surveys and Board records relating to the acquisition of Manxonia House in October 2016 and the subsequent ownership and redevelopment by the Board.

REPLY

The final decision, after review, is that Port St Mary Commissioners upholds the reasons for refusal, however accept that there is a public interest case. The review also identified that this was not a specific request and would be a burden on the Authority to complete. Therefore, the following documents are being released;
